Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the appeal of the petitioner is pending before Commissioner (Appeals-I), Inland Revenue, Karachi and due to apprehension of coercive action, this petition was filed. He further argued that stay application was also moved before the Commissioner (Appeals-I), Inland Revenue, Karachi but no order was passed on it. No reply has been filed by the Tax Department so far. Learned counsel pointed out an order passed in C.P.No.D-5030 of 2017, when the learned Division Bench of this court disposed of the petition with the directions to the respondents not to enforce the recovery of impugned demand which is subject matter of appeal before Commissioner Inland

Revenue Appeals-IV till its final disposal. It was further observed that in the order that the Commissioner (Appeals-IV) Inland Revenue, Karachi may decide the appeal of the petitioner preferably within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of this order. The learned Division Bench passed further order that in case of any adverse order passed by the Commissioner (Appeals) against the petitioner the respondents may not enforce the recovery of impugned demand for another period of seven (7) days to enable the petitioner to seek further remedy. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that same order may be passed in this case. Order accordingly.

The petition is disposed of along with pending application.
