After hearing the learned counsel for the parties at some length, learned counsel for applicant submits that he would be satisfied and shall not press this bail application, if appropriate directions are given to the trial Court to at least examine the complainant, injured and Magistrate within a period of 60 days after receipt of this order, whereafter the applicant would be at liberty to move fresh bail application before the trial Court on fresh ground, if he so desired.

Learned D.P.G has not raised any objection on the above proposition.

In view of above, this bail application stands disposed of with direction to the trial Court to record the evidence of complainant, injured and Magistrate, before whom the confessional statement was recorded, within period of 60 days after receipt of this order and whereafter the applicant would be at liberty to file fresh bail application before the trial Court on fresh ground, if he so desired and trial Court shall then decide the same in accordance with law.
