Dr. Shah Nawaz, learned counsel for the tax department admits that the appeal of the plaintiff is pending before the Appellate Tribunal, Inland Revenue and he undertakes that till the decision of the appeal the department will not take any coercive action against the plaintiff. On instructions, the counsel holding brief for the plaintiff's counsel agreed to this proposal, however, he added that if the appellate order goes against the plaintiff then at least 07 days' time may also be allowed to the plaintiff to seek appropriate remedy in accordance with law on which learned counsel for the tax department has no objection. The suit is disposed of accordingly along with pending application. However, it is expected that the learned Appellate Tribunal, Inland Revenue will decide the pending appeal preferably within a period of one month and no undue adjournment will be sought by the plaintiff to linger on the matter.
