This petition was directed against the findings of the two Family Courts. Precisely this petition was not maintainable at all. However, an attempt was made by the learned counsel for the petitioner to point out certain infirmity with reference to the interpretation of the evidence; his only contention was that the Courts below have not appreciated the **Exh. F/1** to **F/17** in correct perspective in respect of the jewellery claimed by Respondent No.1 in her suit for dissolution of marriage and recovery of dower amount. On examination of the evidence and of course the impugned order of the Appellate Court, it is clear that order of trial Court about return of jewellary is modified to the extent that only those receipts in which the date is prior to the date of marriage would be omitted for return and no other exhibits, therefore, this contention has no force. However, this order is in continuation of order dated 6.11.2018 and the unpaid maintenance shall be paid in installment. The petitioner shall pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- per month including current month maintenance. The amount over and above current month maintenance shall be adjusted toward payment of arrears of past maintenance. The order of 20% per annum increase in maintenance shall be simple interest on Rs.5000/- per month and not compound interest.

The petition alongwith pending application is disposed of in above terms.
