Earlier in this case Qazi Athar Ali advocate was appearing for the petitioner, however, on 16.01.2019 an application for disposal of this petition was filed by the petitioner with supporting affidavit of Abdul Razzak who is the same person who verified the petition as Executive Director of Indus Development Organization. On last date, we asked Mr. Sarfaraz Ali Metlo, learned counsel for the petitioner that this petition has been filed by Indus Development Organization which is allegedly an NGO Whether said NGO has passed a resolution

or authorized their Executive Director to withdraw this petition? Learned counsel sought some time and today along with statement he has submitted Board Resolution duly signed by Fehmeeda Hussain, Chairperson of Indus Development Organization on 18.01.2019 in which the Organization has authorized Executive Director Abdul Razzaq to withdraw the petition. However, when Qazi Athar Ali advocate was appearing for petitioner, he moved various applications under Order I Rule 10 C.P.C. to implead staff of the Forest Department and Members of the Workers Welfare Association but the order dated 03.10.2018 is clear that after arguing at some length, the learned counsel requested that notice of such applications be deferred and he agreed to seek appropriate remedy. Since the petitioner wants to withdraw this petition on the ground that the Respondents have placed on record approval of the Cabinet of Government of Sindh for reorganization of Forest Department, therefore, they want to withdraw this petition. This petition is dismissed as withdrawn, however, the persons who filed application under Order I Rule 10 C.P.C. to become respondents in this case if want to agitate any issue with regard to the restructuring of the Forest Department they may file their independent petitions in accordance with law. All pending applications are also disposed of.
