**Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J:** Learned counsel argued that the petitioners formed an association in the name and style of “Sanaullah Avenue Residential Association” and an application was sent to the Assistant Registrar, Directorate of Industries, Government of Sindh for the registration of their association. On 07.11.2018 the Provincial Assistant Registrar, Joint Stock Companies, Sindh, Karachi forwarded a letter to the SSP, District Central with the request for verification of the antecedents of subscribers Sanaullah Avenue Residents Association, Block-21, F.B. Area before its registration under the Societies Registration Act, 1860. The grievance of the petitioner is that the verification process has been completed by the concerned SSP and according to his information the report has been forwarded to DIG, Central for approval and or further action but despite lapse of considerable period, no action has been taken.

2. Learned AAG waives notice of this petition and after going through the contents of the petition, he proposed that this petition may be disposed of with some directions to the

respondent No.1 to expedite the process for the purpose of verification. Learned counsel for the petitioner is satisfied. Petition is taken up for hearing by consent and disposed of with the directions to the DIG, Central, Karachi to complete the verification process in accordance with law within twenty (20) days' time and submit the report to respondent No.4. The copy of this order may be transmitted to the Deputy Inspector General of Police (Central) Karachi for information and compliance.
