During course of arguments, learned Counsel for the Petitioner himself admitted that he wants specific performance of the contract but this specific performance of the contract is only possible in the civil suit and not in the constitutional jurisdiction of this Court. It is well settled proposition of law that disputed questions of facts and or factual controversies could not be decided in the writ jurisdiction. We have also seen the contract in which dispute resolution mechanism is also provided. The constitutional petition is not maintainable, which is dismissed in *limine* however, petitioner may avail appropriate remedy in accordance with law.
