Mohammad Ali Mazhar J., The petitioner is engaged in the business of Rent-A-Car and is operating at Jinnah International Airport, Karachi ("JIAK") under the license agreement with Civil Aviation Authority ("CAA"). Through this petition they have sought directions against the respondents No.1/UBER and respondent No.2/Careem, who are also engaged in the private transportation business, not to pick the passengers from JIAK. They have further sought directions against the respondents No.6 to 10 to take action against the respondents No.1 and 2. Learned counsel pointed out page 17 which is license agreement executed in 2015 between CAA and the petitioner, whereby the CAA granted license to establish and operate Rent-A-Car Service in Concourse Hall at Level-I of Jinnah Terminal at Jinnah International Airport, Karachi in which certain terms and conditions are also provided. In case of any violation or breach of the license agreement or any directions against respondents 1 and 2 it is the responsibility of the CAA to look into the matter and if the terms and conditions of the license are considered to be violated by the CAA, the petitioner may file a civil suit for injunction rather than this constitutional petition, seeking directions against the two private entities. The petition is dismissed in limine. The learned counsel

submits that the petitioner will file civil suit for appropriate remedy.
