The petitioner is a civil servant working as Junior Clerk in Education Department and by means of this petition has challenged the order dated 14.11.2018 whereby he has been directed to report to office of Secretary, School Education and Literacy Department, Karachi.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is called absent and on his behalf Ms. Rehana Siddiqui, Advocate, is holding brief. We have asked her to satisfy the court as to how a civil servant can file Constitutional Petition against his transfer order; she has no reply.

In our view this petition is not maintainable on account of bar under Article 212 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973. If the petitioner is aggrieved by the impugned order, he can avail a remedy before the Service Tribunal. Accordingly, this petition is dismissed in limine being non-maintainable alongwith listed applications.
