After arguing the case at considerable length, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted, upon instructions, that the petitioner would not press this petition and withdraw the same if this Court may be pleased to observe that no adverse action may be taken by the respondents, with respect to the petitioner's continued occupation of government accommodation, otherwise than in accordance with law. Learned counsel for the petitioner also requested that prior to taking any action against the petitioner the respondents may reconsider the petitioner's request for continued occupation of the government accommodation, on purely humanitarian grounds.

2. Learned Assistant Advocate General is present and submits that request made on behalf of the petitioner is reasonable and that there is no cavil for the same to be acceded to.

3. In view of the request of the learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition, along with the pending applications, is hereby dismissed as withdrawn. It is, however, observed that the respondents shall act in accordance with law and shall not take any action against the petitioner without following the due process prescribed in such regard. We would also expect that the respondents to consider the request made by the petitioner for continuing in occupation of the government accommodation on humanitarian grounds and decide the same in accordance with law.
