Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J.: On 07.01.2015 while issuing notices to the respondents, court passed an order that any proceedings arising from the show cause notice may be continued but no coercive action will be taken against the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during pendency of this case Commissioner Appeals has decided the matter and the petitioner has also preferred an appeal to the Appellate Tribunal Inland Revenue. He proposed that the petition may be disposed of with directions to the Appellate Tribunal Inland Revenue to decide the said appeal within the reasonable period and meanwhile department may be directed not to take any coercive action against the petitioner. Mr. Mohsin Imam, advocate for the respondent No.3 has no objection to this proposal.

2. The petition alongwith pending applications is disposed of with directions to the learned Appellate Tribunal Inland Revenue to dispose of the appeal of the petitioner preferably within 30 days and till decision of appeal, the respondents shall not take any coercive action against the petitioner.
