Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J: The learned counsel for NADRA has submitted a statement in which it is stated that the CNIC of petitioner No.1 was blocked by OIC (Office Incharge Centre). The petitioner No.1 visited the branch but did not provide documentary evidence. The I.B. has advised to carry out the verification of national status of petitioner No.1 with two witnesses. It is further stated that the petitioner No.1 is required to visit V&R Branch along with 02 witnesses with their contact numbers. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that CNICs of petitioner Nos.2 and 3, who are sons of petitioner No.1 have been cleared, but CNIC of petitioner No.1 has been blocked without any justifiable reason. He further argued that the petitioner No.1 has no real brother and sister and she will appear before the concerned NADRA office with her cousins who will testify as required by NADRA. If everything is found in order the CNIC of the petitioner No.1 shall be unblocked. The entire exercise shall be completed within a period of one month
