Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J: At the very outset, learned counsel for the respondent No.1 pointed out page No. 77 which is a blank form and at the same time he requested us to see his statement filed on 02.11.2018 in which it is stated that the petitioner had applied for loan in Prime Minister Youth Business Loan Scheme but he had not provided complete information. It is further stated in the same statement that as and when the petitioner will submit duly filled up “Sales lead Information Form” along with required documents, the respondent bank will evaluate the case and make a credit decision as per credit risk policy of the bank. Learned counsel for the petitioner pointed out an advertisement which is available at page No. 15 with regard to

Prime Minister Youth Business Loan. He further pointed out loan policy which is available at page No. 37 and onward. He argued that all formalities have been completed but the loan was not sanctioned without any lawful justification. On the contrary, learned counsel for the respondent No.1 reiterated that the format of form available at page No. 77 has not been filled up and handed over to the bank.

2. Be that as it may, the petitioner may submit sales lead information form to the respondent No. 1 & 2 within a week and also attach all relevant documents. Learned counsel for the respondent No.1 & 2 categorically stated that the scheme is still going on and the loan may be granted to the petitioner provided that he will fulfill all requisite formalities. After submitting form by the petitioner, his case will be processed by the respondent No.1 & 2 and decision shall be taken within three weeks. Petition is disposed of in above terms.
