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**Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J.** Though the matter is fixed for orders on urgent application along with another Misc. Application (CMA No.23529/2019) filed under Order 1 Rule 10 CPC, whereby the petitioner wants to implead NAB in this petition, but the gist of the case is that the petitioner has prayed for the directions against the respondents to defreeze the commercial plot No.C-59-C, Al-Murtaza Lane No.1, Phase VIII, DHA Karachi from their record and issue NOC in favour of the petitioner in respect of the said plot.

2. Learned counsel for DHA pointed out their comments and at page 27 of the court file a letter dated 9.02.2010 is available to show that the D.H.A. intimated the petitioner that NAB has directed them to mark 'Caution' on the plot in question. At page 29 a letter sent by Additional Director, NAB to the Secretary, D.H.A. Karachi on 17.12.2009 is available, which letter shows that Reference No.24/2000 is pending

against Choudhry Muhammad Sharif, Ex-DD FIA and others and in the list of plots the plot of the petitioner is also mentioned. Since the DHA has marked 'Caution' under the directions of the NAB, therefore, it would be appropriate for the petitioner to approach the NAB court where the NAB Reference is pending and file proper application. Learned D.A.G. submits that if any such application is filed the same shall be decided in accordance with law within a period of 40 days. The petition is disposed of accordingly.
