Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J: Though the petitioner has approached this court for directions against the respondents to grant citizenship to her husband Arshad Hussain so that she may live with her spouse in Pakistan. The alternate prayer is for the directions to respondents to grant Pakistan Origin Card to her husband. Learned counsel for the NADRA has submitted a statement in which it is clearly stated that the petitioner has been cleared along with her children, but her husband Arshad Hussain is a confirmed alien on the basis of Foreign Registration Officer's letter. Learned counsel for the petitioner admits that the husband of the petitioner is Indian National. When we raised a query whether the husband of the petitioner has applied for the citizenship of Pakistan, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no

such application has been moved under the Citizenship Act or enabling Rules.

2. Learned D.A.G. is of the view that until such application

is filed in the Ministry of Interior for the grant of citizenship,

no efforts can be made either for accepting or rejecting the

application. Learned counsel for the petitioner has agreed

that the petitioner's husband will apply for the citizenship in

accordance with law, but he requests that some directions

may be issued to the respondents to decide such application

expeditiously. On which the learned D.A.G. states that the

application of the petitioner's husband shall be decided

within a period of 45 days provided the he files application for

citizenship. Let the husband of the petitioner apply for the

citizenship of Pakistan, thereafter, the application will be

decided by the respondent No.1 in accordance with law within

a period of 45 days. The petition is disposed of.
