The petitioner Muhammad Azam is being represented by her daughter Faiza Amber. She has submitted a copy of special power of attorney duly executed by her father on 25.08.2017 in her favour. The petitioner has approached this court for directions against the respondents to cancel NARA Card on the ground that he is Pakistani National and further directions have been sought against the respondents de-block his CNIC.

Learned counsel for the NADRA submitted a statement on 08.02.2018 in which it is stated that Federal Ministry of Interior has provided a verification mechanism which is being dealt by concerned district level committee hence the petitioner is required to appear before the Deputy Commissioner, Karachi South along with all relevant documents for the purpose of verification. Today again Ch. Muhammad Farooq, Assistant Director (Legal), NADRA submits that the petitioner may approach to the concerned office where the matter will be resolved in accordance with law. At this juncture, attorney of

the petitioner submits that the petitioner is unwell, however, she will make proper arrangement to produce the petitioner before the Deputy Commissioner, South Karachi on 04.09.2018 at 11:00 a.m. The concerned authority shall ensure that entire verification process shall be completed within thirty (30) days and if everything is found in order the CNIC issued by the respondents to the petitioner shall be de-blocked after cancelation of NARA card, if any. The petition is disposed of accordingly.
