Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J: The petitioners have approached this court with the sole prayer that the Respondents No. 1 to 8 may be directed not to harass the petitioners from their right to movement and right to business. They further prayed for directions not to cancel their respective CNIC cards. Ms. Samina Iqbal, Assistant Director (Legal) NADRA has submitted the statement in the following terms: -

"It is respectfully submitted that the petitioners have sought for direction to avoid apprehension of harassment as well as cancellation of their respective CNICs. The grievance of the petitioners may be attended case to case basis as per Law & Policy, accordingly. The petitioners have not provided the complete details in between the lines of Memo of Petition. Hence, the Petitioners may be directed for appearance before V&R Branch, RHO NADRA Karachi alongwith Original Documents to redress their grievance, if any as per law.

So far as the compliance of NADRA laws is concerned, the Petitioners have to comply with all requisite formalities. Ms. Samina Iqbal, learned counsel for NADRA has clearly stated that neither NADRA has caused any harassment to the Petitioners nor they will do so in future and will act in accordance with law. The learned Additional Advocate General Sindh referred to the comments filed by the DIG, West Zone and DSP Shadman, Karachi and stated that no harassment has been caused by the police officials and in future also they will act strictly in accordance with law. The learned counsel for the Petitioners is satisfied to these statements. The petition is disposed of accordingly alongwith pending application(s).
