Learned counsel for the Decree holder states that despite her best efforts she was not able to ascertain details of the assets of the judgment debtor and requests that she should be dispensed with filing a statement which she sought to be filed through order dated 14.02.2018 and presses her decree and requests that the same be executed in accordance with law. A brief is held for Mr. Naveed Ahmed Khan, Advocate who is reportedly busy before another bench of this Court. Learned counsel for Decree holder requests that though judgment debtors have been served and they engaged the counsel however no objections have been filed and by way of least measures as prescribed under Order XXI Rule 23-A the judgment debtor be directed to deposit the decretal amount in the Court or furnishes a security for such payment. Learned counsel draws Court's attention to the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of Pakistan against the judgment and decree, wherein an appeal was preferred bearing Civil Appeal No.193-K of 2009 whereby on 18.04.2016 the appeal was dismissed. A copy of the said judgment is provided.

In the circumstances at hand, the Official Assignee is mandated to have the decree executed as per law by attaching properties of the judgment debtor corresponding with the amount due under the decree.
