Mr. Muhammad Nawaz, advocate for the applicant. Applicants are present in person.

- 1. Urgency is granted.
- 2. Exemption granted subject to all just exceptions.
- 3. Applicants/Accused are nominated in the FIR No.19 of 2018 registered at P.S Jati, District Sujawal, Karachi under Sections 324, 147, 148, 149, 114 337-A(i), 337-F(i) and 35 PPC.

It appears that Applicants have filed bail application before the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sujawal, but the same was dismissed by order dated 05.06.2018, hence applicants preferred this application for bail before arrest on the ground that the applicants are innocent and law abiding citizens. It is further alleged that the names of the applicants have been mentioned in the FIR by the complainant due to enmity and the police is behind the applicants for their malafide arrest. It is also alleged that there is inordinate delay of about 18 hours between incident and FIR.

I have gone through the judgment of the trial Court refusing the bail before arrest. The Applicants/accused are nominated in the FIR with specific role assigned to each one of them and the learned counsel himself has admitted that there is enmity between the parties. Therefore, no case of pre-arrest bail is made out since requirement of pre-arrest bail is that there is possibility of malice or humiliation by the complainant side which is lacking in the instant case.

In view of above and since the applicants are nominated in the FIR and the offence is of serious nature and carries punishment for life, no case for grant of bail before arrest is made out. Therefore, instant Crl. Bail Application for before arrest is dismissed.
