In compliance of this Court's order Secretary Board of Revenue, Sindh Mr. Nadeem-ur-Rehman is present as well as concerned Mukhtiarkar Wazir Chand. Learned counsel for Defendant Nos.2 and 3 draws Court's attention to the order dated 05.10.2016 and the report submitted in compliance thereof received in this Court on 06.03.2018 and states that while this Court mandated the concerned Senior Member Board of Revenue to conduct departmental proceedings against Mukhtiarkar (Ahmed Memon) on account of taking different stances before the Court (which report infact is filed by Secretary is not by Senior Member Board of Revenue) is vague and is not confirming to the procedure to be adopted for conducting such inquiries. Court has been once again moved for grant of some extra time so that an inquiry as envisaged by this Court's order be concluded. Court has been informed that the position of Senior Member Board of Revenue, Sindh is vacant and Secretary Board of Revenue would conclude the inquiry within 20 days, provided however the undertaking having been given in the open Court that the said delinquent officer would be relieved from his charge till the pendency of this inquiry and its determination by this Court. Confirmation in this regard that the said officer has been relieved vide Notification No.20-13-2018-Estt-III/1144 dated 18.09.2018 has been submitted in this Court in later hours, which is taken on record.
