Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J: At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners argued that the appeals before the Appellate Tribunal Inland Revenue filed by the petitioners are pending adjudication. He proposed that both the petitions may be disposed of with the directions to the learned Appellate Tribunal Inland Revenue to decide the pending appeals of the petitioners within a period of one month and if the appellate order goes against the petitioners they may be allowed to seek appropriate remedy and till such time no

coercive action may be taken against them. Mr. Kafeel Ahmed Abbasi advocate agreed to this proposal.

- 2. By consent both the petitions are disposed of along with pending applications in the following terms:-
- i). Learned Appellate Tribunal Inland Revenue may preferably decide the pending appeals of the petitioners within a period of one (01) month. Till such time no coercive action shall be taken by the Department and in case the appellate order goes against the petitioners they may be allowed to seek appropriate remedy within seven (07) days and during this seven days also the Tax Department shall not take any coercive action.
