**Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J:** The petitioner has challenged the letter dated 07.09.2018 issued by the Administrator of respondent No.3 for termination of petitioner's son Master Syed Azan Ali from school which is reproduced as under:-

Principal, Judith Bradshaw and Vice Principal Sajida Khan submit that various chances have already been given to the parents of Syed Azan Ali but no improvement was found in his behavior and conduct. Ultimately, the school is left with no option but to terminate him from school. Petitioner present in person submits that he is making all best possible efforts for improvement and conduct of his son and in future the school will have no complaint against him for any inappropriate behavior or bad language. He also agrees to submit an undertaking in writing to the school for future good conduct and behavior of his son. Principal, Judith Bradshaw and Vice Principal Sajida Khan in order to protect the future of Master Syed Azan Ali have agreed to provide one more chance for the improvement and next time if the conduct and behavior of the child is found indecent and inappropriate his admission will be cancelled. The petitioner has agreed to the above terms and assured to abide.

3. The petition is disposed of accordingly. The petitioner shall submit an undertaking in writing tomorrow at 10:00 a.m. in the office of Principal/Administrator of respondent No.3 and Syed Azan Ali will be allowed to sit in his class from tomorrow.
