Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J: Though these petitions are fixed on urgent motion but the respondents are present and they have also filed comments. By consent, matters are taken up for hearing of main petition. The petitioners have filed this petition for direction against the respondents not to restrain them from travelling to their country Bangladesh. They have also sought a declaration that they are entitled to travel to their native place

Bangladesh on the basis of permission of Government of Bangladesh through their travel permits.

2. Inspector Afroz Ahmed Khan, FIA Immigration has submitted the comments of respondent No. 3 & 4 in which certain requirements have been jot down for compliance. Officials of the Special Branch are also present and they submit that the basic requirement is to provide travel permission issued by High Commission of Bangladesh, thereafter, the Special Branch will obtain the order of the Home Department and letter from Foreign Registration Office, Special Branch, Karachi for the deportation of the petitioners. The officials present in court submit that if the petitioners will comply with all requisite formalities there shall be no delay on their part and they will process the matter expeditiously for the deportation of the petitioners to their native place. The petitioners' counsel agrees to this proposal and submits that all documents will be supplied to the Home Department and FIA by the petitioners within seven (07) days and if all required documents are submitted, the FIA and Special Branch shall expedite the matter and decide the same within one month. Petitions are disposed of accordingly.
