For the reasons to follow, the application for seeking permission to compound the offence u/s 345(2) Cr.P.C. is allowed and consequently the application to accept the compromise u/s 345(6) Cr.P.C. is also allowed.

As a result of above, the impugned judgment dated 16.11.2019, passed by the learned 1<sup>st</sup> Additional Sessions Judge / Model Criminal Trial Court, Shaheed Benazirabad, in Sessions Case No.707 of 2014 (re: The State v. Rizwan Ali and another), arising out of Crime No.69/2014, registered at P.S.
