Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J: Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that since application for permission to run terminal has been moved to the transport department which is still pending therefore some directions may be issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the said application in accordance with law. One intervener Al-Azam Services Private Limited has filed an application under order 1 rule 10 CPC for impleading them as a necessary party. It is stated that by the counsel that if this application is allowed, this will cause inconvenience to the general public and also harm to the petitioner who is also a terminal operator. Shariq Ahmed, Secretary Transport Department, Govt. of Sindh submits that the application filed by the petitioner is pending, which will be decided within 15 days to which learned counsel for the petitioner is satisfied. This petition is disposed of with the directions to the Secretary Transport to decide the pending application filed by the petitioner after providing ample opportunity of hearing to them as well as representative of Al-Azam Services Private Limited (intervener). The date of hearing shall be communicated in writing to the petitioner as well as intervener and speaking order shall be passed by the respondent No.2.
