Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J: The case of the petitioners is that vide notification dated 13.12.2018, Mines and Mineral Development Department, Government of Sindh issued permit for Silica Sand over an area of 200.00 acres to the petitioners without the right to ownership of land, at or near Misree Faqeer, District Jamshoro as per the map for a period of five years. Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that despite a valid permit issued by the competent authority the respondents No.2 to 7 are interfering in the peaceful business of the petitioners so they may be directed not to create any hindrance and harassment.

Today, SIP. Misri Khan Khoso, SHO of Police Station Jhirk and SIP. Shahid Abbasi, SHO of Police Station SITE, Kotri on behalf of SSP Jamshoro are present in Court. A statement has been filed on behalf of the respondent No.3 wherein it is clearly mentioned that he has not rendered any inconvenience to the petitioners and on receiving of the order dated 04.06.2020 he has circulated the said order to the concerned DSP and SHO of Kotri Police Station for strict compliance. It is further stated that neither they have caused any harassment nor intend to take any illegal action against the petitioners in future and they will perform their duties strictly in accordance with law. The said statement is taken on record. Learned AAG is also of the view that the permit is valid till its expiry date and the Mines and Mineral Development Department, Government of Sindh has not raised any objection and they have no issue with the petitioners with regard to the valid permit.

The Petition is disposed of with the directions to the Respondents No.2 to 7 to act strictly in accordance with law and they will not cause any hindrance and harassment to the Petitioners' business in view of the valid permit. Pending applications are also disposed of.
