Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J: The learned D.A.G. submits that now the Anti-Dumping Appellate Tribunal is functioning, therefore, this petition may be disposed of with some directions to respondent No.6 to decide the pending appeal of the petitioners within a reasonable period of time. We raised the query to the learned counsel for the petitioners as to whether any application for interim relief was also moved alongwith the main appeal on which the learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he will also approach to the Appellate Tribunal for some interim order but till such application is taken up for hearing, some restraining orders may be passed against the respondent No.5 not to take any coercive action against the petitioner. The learned D.A.G. has no objection to this proposal. This petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.6 to decide the main appeal of the petitioners within 45 days. The petitioners may also approach to the Appellate Tribunal for some interim orders within 10 days and till such time no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioners by respondent No.5 and the learned Appellate Tribunal will decide the stay application expeditiously. Pending application is also disposed of.
