Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J: The petitioner has approached this court for the declaration that failure of respondents to declare the result of examination of M. Phil (Anatomy) students of BS-2018 is illegal and he further prayed that the petitioner may be allowed to participate in seminar.

2. On notice Dr. Sanam Ali Assistant Professor, Head of Department of Anatomy and Dr. Mehboob Alam, Coordinator, Basic Medical Science Institute have filed comments. They have also attached copy of result at page 13 of their comments dated 05.03.2019 for M. Phil/Ph.D Foundation Course Result (Anatomy) 2018-2019. The name of the petitioner is appearing at Sr. No.2 and he has secured 71 marks in Biostatistics Epidemiology and Research Methodology, 75 marks in Laboratory Management, Biosafety and Medical Ethics and he secured 45 marks in Molecular Biology, Genetics and Bioinformatics. There is a confusion which the learned counsel argued that in some WhatsApp message petitioner was conveyed that he succeeded in the examination but the ground reality is that according to result submitted by the

respondents, he could not qualify the subject Molecular Biology. Dr. Sanam Ali submits that respondent's institution is arranging retake examination for the unsuccessful candidates/ students which will be held in the first week of November, 2020 and she further submits that tentative date for the seminar would be in the mid of November, 2020. She further stated that the petitioner has to appear in the retake examination for the above subject. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner argued that the petitioner is ready to sit in the retake examination in the first week of November, 2020 and if he succeeds in the examination he may be allowed to submit research paper for participation in the seminar. He further prays that petitioner may be allowed to submit research paper subject to the result of retake examination. Dr. Sanam Ali Head of Anatomy, JPMC pointed out that she has already asked the petitioner to submit proposal and she has also asked to Dr. Ambreen Usmani to act as supervisor but the petitioner failed to approach and contact her. The petitioner shall submit his research paper subject to final result of retake examination within three days and if the petitioner is qualified in the retake then he will be allowed to submit his proposal in the seminar after due compliance. By consent this petition is disposed of according along with pending application in the above terms.
