Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J: Precisely, the petitioners are the advocates of this court and in the larger public interest they have moved this petition with the prayer for the directions against the respondents to implement Sindh Health Care Commission Act, 2013 in its letter and spirit. They have also sought the directions to the respondents to shut down unlicensed Health Care Establishment. On 12.08.2020 learned AAG has given a clear statement that since the law is in field that has to be fully implemented. Whereas, the progress reports have also been filed by the Sindh Health Care Commission by the Acting CEO and Acting CEO also appeared in court and gave a clear statement that they are fully implementing the Law and on daily basis they are

receiving the complaints and also investigating different complaints against the Health Care Establishments and in case of lapses they are also imposing fines. She further stated that action is also being taken against the quackeries.

2. Learned counsel for the Sindh Health Care Commission reiterates that all progress reports have been submitted for showing performance of the Sindh Health Care Commission that they are fully observing the Law and necessary actions are being taken which is basically a prime duty of the said establishment and the petitioners have also prayed for the said implementation.

3. In view of the above, this petition is disposed of with clear directions to the Sindh Health Care Commission to continue their performance by observing all provisions contained in the Act and Regulations vigilantly. They will also continue to take strict action against the violation of the provisions of the Act, if any, committed by the Health Care Establishments and also against the quackeries in the larger public interest.
