Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J: In compliance of the last order the learned counsel for the Respondent (Bahria University Karachi Campus) has submitted a statement. He has also attached a copy of letter dated 16.11.2020 in which it is stated that in compliance of the order dated 12.11.2020 a committee was constituted for allocating/recounting the marks of the petitioner's Thesis. The committee has submitted its report with the observation that the allocated marks are justified and fair marking is done with respect to the student Thesis work.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no opportunity was provided to the petitioner for appearing before the committee, on which the learned counsel for the respondent submits that a letter was issued to the petitioner but petitioner's counsel submits that no such letter was ever received by the

petitioner for appearing before the committee. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the petitioner may be directed to appear before the committee to justify his case which will be decided in accordance with relevant rules and regulation of the university.

The learned counsel for the petitioner argued that the petitioner has submitted his Thesis on the topic “Supply Chain Management” and requests that for awarding the marks of Thesis, subject specialist should be included in the committee, who will be the best judge to give numbers. The learned counsel for the respondent submits that the petitioner may appear before the committee on 30.11.2020 at 10:00 a.m. in the office of Director General, Bahria University, Karachi Campus, near National Stadium, Karachi, so that the committee members will provide fair opportunity of hearing to him and pass proper order in accordance with Thesis Rules for onward transmission to the Registrar and Director General, Bahria University Karachi.

4. At this juncture, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the upcoming convocation will be held on 06th December, 2020, therefore, he requests that some directions may be issued to the committee members to decide the case of the petitioner before convocation. On which learned counsel for the respondent agrees that the committee will decide the matter before convocation. The petition is disposed of accordingly.
