Muhammad Ali Mazhar J., The petitioner has prayed for the direction to the respondent to process and issue Endowment Scholarship Cheque in favour of the petitioner in accordance with rules and regulations. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner pointed out the letter dated 6th March, 2019, available at page 17 of the case file which was written by the Additional Secretary (A&T)/Endowment to the Registrar, Al-Tibri Medical College, Isra University, Karachi Campus with regard to the Endowment Fund Scholarship of students of that college for the year 2016 (Renewal). Contents of the letter are produced as under:

"I am directed to inform that the Renewal case of Endowment Fund Scholarship for the year 2016 (renewal of Ms. Nazish Naeem D/o Mian Naeemuddin Ahmed, student of MBBS Final year of your College is under process. 2. You are therefor requested to kindly allow her to attend the classes and appear in the forthcoming examination as well. The endowment fund for the year 2016 (renewal) will be released to your college shortly."

The grievance of the petitioner is that despite writing this letter to the college on 6th March, 2019 the payment has not been released and the college is asking for the payment of the petitioner, but due to meager sources the petitioner could not arrange the payment. When confronted with this letter, learned AAG proposed that this petition may be disposed of in the terms of this letter with certain directions to the respondents to comply with the same. The proposal given by the learned AAG seems to be reasonable. The petition is disposed of with the directions to the respondents to comply with the letter dated 6th March, 2019 within three weeks and release the payment accordingly directly to the college.
