Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J.: In compliance of the order dated 15.10.2019, a compliance report alongwith certain recommendations has been submitted by Mr. Ghulam Yaseen, Deputy Director, Anti-Quackery, Sindh Health Care Commission. He submitted that he personally conducted inspection of the laboratory and in the compliance report he has forwarded some recommendations including that Nice Care Medical Center and Laboratory should apply for registration to the SHCC and provide services according to minimum standards of laboratory, with further caution that all diagnostic reports must be verified and signed by pathologist consultant and the certificate of lab technician is also required to be renewed by the competent authority. The learned counsel for the

petitioner after going through the compliance report agrees to comply with all requisite formalities provided in the Sindh Healthcare Commission Act, 2013. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submitted that they have collected the form from the office which will be submitted in due course and the Deputy Director present in court also undertakes that after all codal formalities are complied with by the petitioner, the registration certificate shall be issued in accordance with law. The officer further submitted that the laboratory has already been de-sealed by the authorities. Let the entire exercise should be completed within the period of one month and the registration certificate may be issued to the petitioner in accordance with law. The petition is disposed of with pending application.
