



Through this petition, the petitioner has prayed that respondents be directed to issue appointment order in his favour for the post of Excise and Taxation Inspector (BPS-14). He has claimed in paragraphs 5, 6 and 8 of the petition that he had passed the written test as well as the interview / viva voce and his name was also mentioned in the merit list issued by the Departmental Selection Committee. It appears that his entire claim / relief is based on the above assertion. However, he has not filed a single document along with the petition to show that he had passed the written test and interview / viva voce and/or his name had appeared in the merit list. It is surprising to note that the petition is pending since last about eight years, but during this entire period no attempt whatsoever has been made by the petitioner to place on record any document that may support his above contention. In the above circumstances, the petitioner has failed to substantiate his claim as a successful candidate and as such is not entitled to any relief. Accordingly, the petition and listed application are dismissed with no order as to costs with the observation that if any relief is granted to any of the petitioners in C.P No.D-150 of 2008 and others, the same treatment should also be given to the present petitioner, however, subject to all just exceptions.
