Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J: The case of the petitioner is that they have established Medical College in 2007 at Tando Adam along with 120 bed hospital namely Suleman Roshan Medical College Hospital. Their grievance is that despite filing application, the predecessor of the respondent No.3 Pakistan Medical & Dental Council could not pay any heed to the application and issue of recognition is pending for last three years. They have sought the directions against the respondent No. 2 & 3 to initiate the recognition process. One of the basic conditions before awarding recognition is the inspection of the institution which earlier PMDC was conducting and now in the new Law Pakistan Medical Commission has been constituted to conduct inspection and to deal with the matter

of recognition. Mr. Zeeshan Abdullah advocate has filed vakalatnama for respondent No.2&3 along with statement of respondent No. 2 and 3 in which it is stated that PMC is finalizing the inspection process with the timeline to carry out pending inspections in the month of December, 2019. It is categorically stated that the petitioner's college will also be inspected in the month of December, 2019 without any delay. The statement signed by the learned counsel on instructions of respondent No. 2 & 3 is taken on record.

2. The petition is disposed of along with pending application with the directions to respondent No.3 to conduct the inspection of the petitioner institution on or before 10th December, 2019 with advance notice to the college management. After inspection, further recognition process shall be initiated immediately as according to the petitioner, their matter is pending for the last three years which is totally unjustified and respondent No.3 shall fulfill and perform their statutory obligation promptly. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that proper application has already been moved, however, copy of such application forwarded to PMDC shall also be submitted to the PMC through its Secretary and copy will be supplied to Mr. Zeeshan Abdullah advocate.
