Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J: The officers present in court submit that the Liquor License issued to the respondent No.9 for the shop located at plot No.SB-2, KDA Scheme No.A-1, Stadium Road, Karachi, but on the application of the respondent No.9 it was re-located to Shop Nos.1 and 2, Plot No.R-62, Sector 1-A/4, Shahnawaz Bhutto Colony, Khawaja Ajmair Nagri, District Central, Karachi. They further submit that there is no violation of license, but the respondent No.9 running the shop according to rules mentioned in the license.

2. Today the petitioner himself filed an application for the withdrawal of the petition in which he states that he does not want to proceed the matter. Whereas he had prayed in the petition that the respondent Nos.1 to 5 has allowed to run the illegal wine shop by the respondent Nos.8 and 9, but the respondents clearly demonstrate that there is no violation of license and it is only a case of relocation after complying with requisite formalities. On the basis of this fact, the petitioner himself has filed this application for withdrawal of the petition.

3. In view of the above position, the application for withdrawal of petition is allowed and the petition is disposed of as withdrawn. Office is directed to mark CMA number on the application for withdrawal of petition.
