**Muhammad Ali Mazhar, J:**           The Petitioners have sought directions against the Respondent No.2 to explain why grace marks have not been allotted to all the candidates and why they have been declared unqualified. They have further sought directions against the Respondents to allow the Petitioners to appear in the Combined Competitive Examination, 2018.

Learned Additional Advocate General, Sindh has filed comments of the Respondents No.1 and 2, in which it is clearly stated that the Petitioners have failed to secure 50% marks for qualifying screening test.

It is further stated that after qualifying the screening test, the candidates were to be allowed to appear in the written Examination-2018.

So far as the claim of the grace marks, as brought by the Petitioners, the Secretary, Sindh Public Service Commission has already responded that the advantage of invalid questions and their answers was given to all the candidates across the board and despite giving the advantage of invalid questions and answers, the Petitioners could not meet the threshold 50% marks. It is clearly appeared from the reply of the Sindh Public Service Commission that the Petitioners could not qualify the screening test. No further interference is required. The Petition is dismissed accordingly.
