Mr. I. H. Zaidi, advocate for the Petitioner. Mr. Muhammad Ikram Siddiqui, advocate for Respondent No.1.

Both these petitions by virtue of lapse of more than 10 and 11 years respectively have become infructuous since the respondents are no more entitle to claim maintenance from the petitioner. However, learned counsel for the petitioner says that in compliance of the impugned orders certain amount have been paid, which he was not supposed to be paid beyond certain date. Since payments, if any, have been made in the trial Court, he may take this plea in the said Court where he has deposited the amount. It would be for the trial Court to ascertain that how much amount has been paid by him and whether it is refundable or not and / or it is still lying in the trial Court.

In view of the above position, these petitions are dismissed. However, the petitioner may file any such application before the trial Court in accordance with law.
