<u>AHMED ALI M. SHAIKH, CJ</u>.- Petitioner by invoking the Constitutional Jurisdiction of this Court, inter alia, seeks constitution of an inquiry committee to probe the allegations of corruption and corrupt practices alleged against the Respondent No.4.

2. Facts giving rise to the instant petition as portrayed by the petitioner are that petitioner is President of All Sindh Peoples Paramedical Staff Association, Unit-Body Sindh Government Hospital, Karachi, while Respondent No.4, Shahzaib Ali, has been performing duties as Steward (BPS-11) in Sindh Government Hospital, New Karachi, where OPD services to about 3000 patients are being provided daily. It is alleged that the Respondent No.4 due to connivance of Respondents No.2 and 3 has been enjoying the status of a higher grade officer and has been allotted a government bungalow meant for a gazetted officer. On the complaints of the petitioner and other employees of the hospital he was suspended from service but soon reinstated under the garb of an inquiry conducted against him.

3. Having heard the learned Counsel for the petitioner, gone through the material available on record. It appears that the grievance of the petitioner revolves around an inquiry proceeding against the Respondent No.4 pending since 22.07.2019. During course of arguments learned counsel very frankly conceded that the petitioner is neither a party nor has any nexus of whatsoever nature in the said inquiry. Moreover, he failed to show how the fundamental rights of the petitioners guaranteed in the Constitution are being violated. In wake of above, the petition merits no consideration and is accordingly dismissed.
