Through the instant petition, petitioner Syed Fida-a-Asghar Zaiai has prayed for the grant of Letter of Administration in respect of immoveable property/asset, details whereof are mentioned in the Schedule of Property attached with the memo of petition, available at page 25, which was left by his deceased mother, namely, Mst. Syeda Sultan Fatima Naqvi, who allegedly died on 21st August, 2008 at Karachi, leaving behind her eight legal heirs, details whereof are mentioned in paragraph No. 2 of the memo of petition.
