Ms. Seema Wasim, advocate for petitioner.

Through the instant petition, Petitioner Mst. Naseem Akhtar has prayed for the grant of Succession Certificate and Letter of Administration in respect of moveable and immoveable properties/assets, details whereof are mentioned in the Schedule of Properties, available at pages No.17 & 19, which were left by her deceased husband, namely, Nazeer Ahmed s/o. Late Abdul Aziz, who allegedly died on 06.06.2006 at Karachi, leaving behind (1) Mst. Naseem Akhtar (widow/petitioner), (2) Mrs. Naheed Shakoor (daughter), (3) Nadeem Ahmed (Son), (4) Naeem Nazeer (Son), (5) Ms. Tasneem Mustafa (daughter), (6) Ms. Saima Nazeer (daughter), (7) Tehseen Nazeer (Son) and (8) Faheem Nazeer (son) as his legal heirs. Original Death Certificate of deceased as well as photostat copies of Family Registration Certificate, issued by the NADRA, title documents of the immovable properties, bank statements and registration documents of the vehicle are also filed at page 11, 13, 27 to 125 and 127 to 147.

Legal heirs No.2 to 8 have filed their affidavits of no objection for the grant of Succession Certificate and Letter of Administration in favour of the petitioner.

Two witnesses, namely, Muhammad Shahbaz s/o. Muhammad Mukhtar Ahmed and Muhammad Ramzan s/o. Deen Muhammad have also filed their respective affidavits and affirmed

that there is no other legal heir of the deceased except mentioned above. Their affidavits are also available on record.

Notice of this petition was published in Daily "Jang" Karachi and Multan dated 17.10.2019 and 18.10.2019; however, none has filed any objection to the grant of Succession Certificate and Letter of Administration to petitioner, as per the report submitted by the Deputy Registrar (OS) on 31.10.2019.

Today petitioner and legal heirs No.2 to 8 as well as above named witnesses are present. They affirm the contents of memo of petition and their affidavits and also verify their signatures thereon.

Since all the legal formalities/requirements have been fulfilled, there is no impediment in grant of Succession Certificate and Letter of Administration to petitioner, therefore, the petition is allowed. The office is directed to issue Succession Certificate and Letter of Administration in respect of movable and immovable properties/assets shown in the Schedule of Properties, as per rules.
