At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that due to typographical error street number could not be mentioned in the Schedule of Property; therefore, he seeks permission for making necessary correction. Permission is accorded. Let the requisite correction be made with initial.

Through the instant petition, petitioner Syed Farooq Hasan has prayed for the grant of Letter of Administration in respect of immoveable property/asset, details whereof are mentioned in the Schedule of Property attached with the memo of petition, available at page 17, which was left by his deceased wife, namely, Mst. Wasima Farooq Hasan, who allegedly died on 3rd June, 2019 at Karachi, leaving behind her four legal heirs, details whereof are mentioned in paragraph No. 2 of the memo of petition. Original Death Certificate of deceased as well as photostat copies of Family Registration Certificate, issued by the NADRA and title documents of the immovable property are also filed at page 11, 13 and 23 to 130.

Legal heirs No. 2 to 4 have filed their Affidavits of No-Objection for the grant of Letter of Administration in favour of the petitioner/legal heir No.1, which are available on record. Two witnesses, namely, Syed Usman Haider and Qazi Abdul Wahid have also filed their respective affidavits and affirmed that there is no other legal heir of the deceased except mentioned above. Their affidavits are also available on record.

Notice of this petition was published in Daily "Jang" Karachi dated 1st November, 2020; however, none has filed any objection to the grant of Letter of Administration to petitioner, as per the report submitted by the Deputy Registrar (OS) on 19th November, 2020.

Today petitioner and legal heirs No. 2 to 4 as well as above named witnesses are present. They affirm the contents of memo of petition as well as their affidavits and also verify their signatures made thereon.

Since all the legal formalities/requirements have been fulfilled, there is no impediment in grant of Letter of Administration to petitioner, therefore, the petition is allowed. The office is directed to issue Letter of Administration in respect of immovable property/asset shown in the Schedule of Property, as per rules.
