Mr. Alqamah Bin Mehmood, advocate for petitioner.

Through the instant petition, petitioner Ghulam Sabir has prayed for the grant of Letter of Administration in respect of immoveable properties/assets, details whereof are mentioned in the Schedules of Properties attached with the memo of petition, available at page 27 & 29, which were left by his deceased parents, namely, Ghulam Mohiuddin and Mst. Nafees Begum, who allegedly died on 26th July, 2013 and 15th April, 2016, respectively at Karachi, leaving behind them twelve legal heirs, details whereof are mentioned in paragraph No. 2 of the memo of petition. Original Death Certificate of deceased as well as photostat copies of Family Registration Certificate, issued by the NADRA and title documents of the immovable properties are also filed at page 17 to 25 and 37 to 103.

Legal heirs No. 2 to 12 have filed their Affidavits of No-Objection for the grant of Letter of Administration in favour of the petitioner/legal heir No.1, which are available on record.

Two witnesses, namely, Shams Tabraiz Jokhio and Zain Arif have also filed their respective affidavits and affirmed that there is no other legal heir of the deceased except mentioned above. Their affidavits are also available on record.

Notice of this petition was published in Daily "Jang" Karachi dated 19th February, 2021; however, none has filed any objection to the grant of

Letter of Administration to petitioner, as per the report submitted by the Deputy Registrar (OS) on 5th March, 2021.

Today petitioner and legal heirs No. 2 to 12 as well as above named witnesses are present. They affirm the contents of memo of petition as well as their affidavits and also verify their signatures made thereon.

Since all the legal formalities/requirements have been fulfilled, there is no impediment in grant of Letter of Administration to petitioner, therefore, the petition is allowed. The office is directed to issue Letter of Administration in respect of immovable properties/assets shown in the Schedule of Properties, as per rules.
