Through the instant petition, Petitioner, Abdul Ghaffar Khan s/o. Late Abdul Sattar Khan has prayed for the grant of Letter of Administration in respect of immoveable property/asset, details whereof are mentioned in the Schedule of Property attached with the memo of petition, available at page 17, which was left by his deceased wife, namely, Rubina Ghaffar, who died on 04.12.2014 at Karachi, leaving behind Abdul Ghaffar Khan (petitioner), Muhammad Haris Khan, Muhammad Bilal Khan, Muhammad Hamza Khan and Miss Hamna Khan as her legal heirs. Original Death Certificate of deceased as well as photostat copies of Family Registration Certificate, issued by the NADRA and title documents of the immovable property are also filed at page 13, 15 and 23 to 37.

All the legal heirs have filed their affidavits of no objection for the grant of Letter of Administration in favour of the petitioner.

Two witnesses, namely, Abdul Rasheed Johar s/o. Malik Ghulam Muhammad and Muhammad Ahsan s/o. Muhammad Usman have also filed their respective affidavits and affirmed that there is no other legal heir of the deceased except mentioned above. Their affidavits are also available on record.

Notice of this petition was published in Daily "Jang" Karachi dated 10.06.2017; however, none has filed any objection to the

grant of Letter of Administration to petitioner, as per the report submitted by the Deputy Registrar (OS) on 10.08.2017.

Since all the legal formalities/requirements have been fulfilled, there is no impediment in grant of Letter of Administration to petitioner, therefore, the petition is allowed. The office is directed to issue Letter of Administration in respect of immovable property/asset shown in the Schedule of Property, as per rules.
