Through instant petition, the petitioner seeks directions to the official respondents, inter alia. unlawful to remove obstructions/nuisance, containers, cemented bricks and barriers. It is alleged by the petitioner that she is residing within the jurisdiction of Police Station Soldier Bazar which is highly populated area. It is case of the petitioner that the streets described in paragraphs No.3&5 of the petition, are cordon off by the Soldier Bazar Police for approximately three years by installing barriers which are causing great inconvenience to the residents of the locality.

Today, respondent No.4/SHO Police Station Soldier Bazar Karachi East has submitted comments, wherein it has been stated that Shia/Sunni/Ismailiy Communities on the following Islamic dates and on the occasions of the month's of 21st Ramzan, (i) 8th (ii) 9th and (iii) 10 Muharram ul Harram, 20th Safar (Chehlum), 8th & 12th Rabi ul Awwal, Arrival of Agha Khan, Imamat Day, Birthday of Agha Khan, Chand Raat, Nowroz, the following roads/streets were blocked in the territorial limit of under command of Police Station Soldier Bazar in the larger interest of safety of human lives as well as properties:-
