Mr. Liaquat Ali Khan, advocate for petitioner.

Through the instant petition, petitioner, Noman Naeem has prayed for the grant of Succession Certificate in respect of moveable properties/assets, details whereof are mentioned in the Schedule of Properties attached with the memo of petition, available at page 23, which were left by his deceased father, namely, Muhammad Naeem s/o. Abdul Haleem, who allegedly died on 20.06.2020 at Karachi, leaving behind (1) Mst. Tasneem Begum (widow), (2) Noman Naeem (son/petitioner), (3) Madiha Hassan (daughter), (4) Wajiha (daughter), (5) Farhan Naeem (son) and (6) Hanzala Naeem (son) as his legal heirs. Original Death Certificate of deceased as well as photostat copies of Family Registration Certificate, issued by the NADRA, statements of account and letter of Faysal Bank Limited, Binoria SITE branch, Karachi regarding Faysal Islamic Saving Growth Fund are also filed at page 15, 19, 21 and 27 to 33.

Legal heirs No. 1 and 3 to 6 have filed their Affidavits of No-Objection for the grant of Succession Certificate in favour of the petitioner.

Two witnesses, namely, Ghazanfar Mahmood s/o. Muhammad Shafi and Shahid Iqbal s/o. Noor Muhammad have also filed their respective affidavits and affirmed that there is no other legal heir of the deceased except mentioned above. Their affidavits are also available on record.

Notice of this petition was published in Daily "Jang" Karachi dated 5th September, 2020; however, none has filed any objection to the grant of Succession Certificate to petitioner, as per the report submitted by the Deputy Registrar (OS) on 17th September, 2020.

Today petitioner and legal heirs No. 1 and 3 to 6 as well as above named witnesses are present. They affirm the contents of memo of petition as well as their affidavits and also verify their signatures made thereon.

Since all the legal formalities/requirements have been fulfilled, there is no impediment in grant of Succession Certificate to petitioner, therefore, the petition is allowed. The office is directed to issue Succession Certificate in respect of movable properties/assets shown in the Schedule of Properties, as per rules.
