Through the instant petition, Petitioner, Sheikh Waseem-ul-Haq has prayed for the grant of Letter of Administration in respect of immoveable property, mentioned in Schedule of properties attached with the memo of petition, available at page 15, which was left by his deceased mother, namely, Naeema Khatoonn w/o Sheikh Naseem-ul-Haq, who died on 11.05.2017, leaving behind Ms. Samina Naseem, Mrs. Sanobar Naseem, Muhammad Ismail and Sheikh Wasee-ul-Haq (petitioner) as her legal heirs. Original Death Certificate of deceased as well as photostat copies of Family Registration Certificate, issued by the NADRA and title documents of the subject property are also filed at pages 11, 13, and 21 to 33.

The legal heirs, namely, Samina Naseem, Mrs. Sanobar Naseem and Muhammad Ismail have filed their affidavits of no objection for the grant of Letter of Administration in favour of the petitioner.

Two witnesses, namely, Muhammad Aqil s/o. Muhammad Taqi and Tahir Saeed s/o. Muhammad Saeed have also filed their respective affidavits and affirmed that there is no other legal heir of the deceased except mentioned above. Their affidavits are also available on record. Publication of main petition has also been effected in Daily Jang, Karachi dated 27.09.2017; however, none

has filed any objection to the grant of Letter of Administration to petitioner.

Since all the legal formalities/ requirements have been fulfilled, there is no impediment in grant of Letter of Administration to petitioner, therefore, the petition is allowed. The office is directed to issue Letter of Administration in respect of immovable property shown in the Schedule of properties, as per rules.
