Through the instant petition, Petitioner Naeem Abbasi has prayed for the grant of Letter of Administration in respect of immoveable properties/assets, details whereof are mentioned in the Schedule of Property attached with the memo of petition, available at page 19, which were left by his deceased father, namely, Maqbool Hussain Khan S/o Gul Hussain Khan, who allegedly died on 09.02.2016 at Azad Kashmir, leaving behind him nine legal heirs, details whereof is mentioned in paragraph No.4 of the memo of petition. Original Death Certificate of deceased as well as photostat copies of Family Registration Certificate, issued by the NADRA and title documents of the immovable properties are also filed at page 11 to 15 and 23 to 97.

Legal heirs No.(g) has filed his affidavit of no objection for the grant of Letter of Administration in favour of the petitioner, while legal heirs No. (a) & (c) to (f), (h) and (i) have also executed Special Power of Attorney, duly attested by the Notary Public at Azad Jammu & Kashmir in favour of the petitioner.

Two witnesses, namely, Kashif Khan Abbasi S/o Muhammad Zahoor Khan and Danish Jameel S/o Jameel Ahmed have also filed their respective affidavits and affirmed that there is no other legal heir of the deceased except mentioned above. Their affidavits are also available on record. Notice of this petition was published in Daily "Jang" Karachi dated 23.11.2020; however, none has filed any objection to the grant of Letter of Administration to petitioner, as per the report submitted by the Deputy Registrar (OS) on 17.12.2020.

Today above named legal heir (g) and witnesses are present. They affirm the contents of their affidavits and also verify their signatures thereon.

Since all the legal formalities/requirements have been fulfilled, there is no impediment in grant of Letter of Administration to petitioner, therefore, the petition is allowed. The office is directed to issue Letter of Administration in respect of immovable property/assets shown in the Schedule of Property, as per rules.
