Through the instant petition, Petitioner Mst. Sughra Begum has prayed for the grant of Letter of Administration in respect of immovable property/asset, details whereof are mentioned in the Schedule of Property attached with the memo of petition, available at page 17, which was left by her deceased husband, namely, Mujtaba Ali s/o. Mustafa Ali, who allegedly died on 22.08.2005 at Karachi, leaving behind (1) Sughar Begum (widow/petitioner), (2) Saima Rehan (daughter), (3) Yasir Ali (son), (4) Umair Ali (son), (5) Uzair Ali (son), (6) Qurat-u-lain (daughter) and Ahmer Ali (son) as his legal heirs. Original Death Certificate of deceased as well as photostat copies of Family Registration Certificate, issued by the NADRA and title documents of the immovable property are also filed at page 11 to 15 and 31 to 43.

Legal heirs No. 2 to 6 have filed their affidavits of no objection for the grant of Letter of Administration in favour of the petitioner.

Two witnesses, namely, Rehan Raees s/o. Abdul Raees Khan and Muhammad Siddique s/o. Saleh Muhammad have also filed their respective affidavits and affirmed that there is no other legal heir of the deceased except mentioned above. Their affidavits are also available on record.

Notice of this petition was published in Daily "Jang" Karachi dated 12.10.2018; however, none has filed any objection to the grant of Letter of Administration to petitioner, as per the report submitted by the Deputy Registrar (OS) on 08.11.2018.

Today above named legal heirs and witnesses are present. They affirm the contents of their affidavits and also verify their signatures thereon.

Since all the legal formalities/requirements have been fulfilled, there is no impediment in grant of Letter of Administration to petitioner, therefore, the petition is allowed. The office is directed to issue Letter of Administration in respect of immovable property/asset shown in the Schedule of Property, as per rules.
