Through the instant petition, Petitioner Muhammad Kamran has prayed for the grant of Letter of Administration in respect of immoveable properties/assets, details whereof are mentioned in the Schedule of Properties attached with the memo of petition, available at page 23, which were left by his deceased father, namely, Muhammad Ismail s/o. Muhammad Usman, who allegedly died on 18.10.2015 at Karachi, leaving behind (1) Mst. Salma Parveen (widow), (2) Abdul Rehman (son) and (3) Muhammad Kamran (son/petitioner) as his legal heirs. Original Death Certificate of deceased as well as photostat copies of Family Registration Certificate, issued by the NADRA and title documents of the immovable properties are also filed at page 19, 21 and 33 to 37.

Legal heirs No. 1 & 2 have executed General Power of Attorney, duly attested by the Notary Public and First Secretary in the Embassy of Pakistan at Doha, Qatar, respectively, in favour of the petitioner, who has filed affidavit of no objection on their behalf for the grant of Letter of Administration in his favour.

Two witnesses, namely, Muhammad Salahuddin s/o. Muhammad Muneruddin and Syed Abdul Wasay s/o. Syed Abdul Sattar have also filed their respective affidavits and affirmed that there is no other legal heir of the deceased except mentioned above. Their affidavits are also available on record.

Notice of this petition was published in Daily "Jang" Karachi dated 13.12.2018; however, none has filed any objection to the grant of Letter of Administration to petitioner, as per the report submitted by the Deputy Registrar (OS) on 17.01.2019.

Today petitioner and above named witnesses are present. They affirm the contents of memo of petitioner as well as their affidavits and also verify their signatures thereon.

Since all the legal formalities/requirements have been fulfilled, there is no impediment in grant of Letter of Administration to petitioner, therefore, the petition is allowed. The office is directed to issue Letter of Administration in respect of immovable properties/assets shown in the Schedule of Properties, as per rules.
