Through the instant petition, petitioner Mst. Yasmeen Begum has prayed for the grant of Succession Certificate and Letter of Administration in respect of moveable and immovable properties/assets, details whereof are mentioned in the Amended Schedule of Properties attached with the memo of petition, available at page 27/A to 27/C and 29, which were left by his deceased husband, namely, Pir Intizamuddin Farooqui s/o. Pir Fasihuddin Farooqui, who allegedly died on 21.12.2018 at Karachi, leaving behind (1) Mst. Yasmeen Begum (widow/petitioner), (2) Samreen Pirzada (daughter), (3) Riazuddin Pirzada (son), (4) Ineramuddin Pirzada (son), (5) Nighat Kanwal (daughter), (6) Ahsan Pirzada (son), (7) Mohsin Pirzada Farooqui (son) and (8) Rabia Pirzada Farooqui as his legal heirs. Original Death Certificate of deceased as well as photostat copies of Family Registration Certificate, issued by the NADRA, title documents of the immovable property and bank statements are also filed at page 23 to 27 and 39 to 121.

Legal heirs No. 2 to 8 have filed their Affidavits of No-Objection for the grant of Succession Certificate and Letter of Administration in favour of the petitioner.

Two witnesses, namely, Abdul Subhan s/o. Hussain Ali and Muhammad Amir Khan Bilalzai s/o. Muhammad Aijaz Khan Bilalzai have also filed their respective affidavits and affirmed that there is no other legal heir of the deceased except mentioned above. Their affidavits are also available on record.

Notice of this petition was published in Daily "Jang" Karachi dated 04.03.2020; however, none has filed any objection to the grant of Succession Certificate and Letter of Administration to petitioner, as per the report submitted by the Deputy Registrar (OS) on 19.03.2020.

Today petitioner and legal heirs No. 2 to 8 as well as above named witnesses are present. They affirm the contents of memo of petition as well as their affidavits and also verify their signatures made thereon.

Since all the legal formalities/requirements have been fulfilled, there is no impediment in grant of Succession Certificate and Letter of Administration to petitioner, therefore, the petition is allowed. The office is directed to issue Succession Certificate and Letter of Administration in respect of movable and immovable properties/assets shown in the Amended Schedule of Properties, as per rules.
